Welcome back, everyone! I hope a relaxing and restful holiday was had by all! We are back into the swing of things at Joamie. Here are a few items of interest for all:

School Security: Joamie School has taken the next step in ensuring the safety for all students and staff. Starting this week, the double lobby doors into the main part of the school will be locked. ALL people visiting the school need to check in at the office and sign the clipboard. Joamie School still welcomes all parents and guests to visit the school!

Drop off times: Some students continue to arrive at school much too early in the morning and after lunch time. This is a huge safety issue. Teachers are not on duty until 8:25am and 12:55pm. Students are not to be on the playground unsupervised. On days when it is colder than -35 C, we do not send the students outside for recess and we allow students to wait in the lobby early before the bell rings. No students should be in the lobby before 8:25am because no one is there to supervise them.

Pick up times: We continue to have students picked up late at lunch time and after school. Please be aware that the bell rings at 11:50am and 3:40pm each day. We expect someone to be there when the bell rings for the safety of all children. Teachers are done supervising once the buses have left the school grounds.
